Coming to Church

With the gradual easing of the national lockdown restrictions, those parishioners who do not fall into the "very vulnerable" category may wish to start coming to church again for Mass.

When in church, please observe the social distancing rules, wear a face covering (unless you are exempt) and sanitise your hands frequently. Please also maintain an appropriate distance from others at all times, both inside the church and outside in the carpark.

If you would like to come to **Mass at the weekends**, please contact the Parish Office to book a place, either by telephone on weekdays between 10.00am-1.00pm, or by email. There is no need to book a place at a weekday Mass but, on arrival at church, please give your details to one of the stewards.

National Day of Prayer and Reflection on the Covid-19 Pandemic

The Prime Minister has designated this Tuesday, 23 March, as a National Day of Reflection to mark the anniversary of the first national lockdown with a minute's silence at 12noon and doorsteps vigils of light at 8.00pm.

A <u>Statement</u> from the Presidency of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has welcomed this initiative, but has asked that we also make it a Day of Prayer, with an encouragement for all Catholics to pay a visit to our churches and pray for the many needs, hopes and sorrows that have emerged over the last year.

Therefore, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for private prayer after Mass in St James until 2.00pm and then at St Boniface from 5.30-7.00pm. Offers of assistance from our stewards to ensure that social distancing and sanitising rules are followed during these times would be greatly appreciated.

Preparing for Holy Week

This year we will have the joy of being able to celebrate Holy Week and the Easter Triduum together, albeit in a modified form due principally to the need to maintain social distancing. Rosie has been dealing with a deluge of bookings this week and the only Services in the Easter Triduum with spaces still available are the Good Friday Service at 12noon in St Boniface, the Good Friday Stations of the Cross at 7.00pm in St James and the Easter Sunday Masses at 10.00am (St James) and 11.30am (St Boniface). All the other Services are now fully booked.

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has issued <u>Guidance</u> with regards to how the Holy Week and Easter Triduum ceremonies are to be celebrated this year. Many of the usual liturgical actions have had to be curtailed or omitted due to Covid restrictions.
