

Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has chosen Tuesday of the Fifth Week of Easter (9 May) as the Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse. This is a day of prayer for those who have been abused, which takes places in a Season of hope and new life.

The Isaiah Journey (a working group of the Bishops' Conference that has grown out of the need for a pastoral-spiritual response to the suffering of victims and survivors of abuse in the Church) has produced a range of resources for use, including many prayers to be used at this time, at <u>https://www.cbcew.org.uk/prayer-for-survivors-of-abuse/</u>. The following prayer for healing and reconciliation has been prepared by the Diocese of Northampton for this year's Day of Prayer:

> Praise to you Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the source of all consolation and hope. Be the refuge and guardian of all who suffer from abuse and violence. Comfort them and send healing for their wounds of the body, soul and spirit. Help us all and make us one with you in your love for justice as we deepen our respect for the dignity of every human life. Giver of peace, make us one in celebrating your praise, both now and forever. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen

CHAT Urgent Appeal



As the cost-of-living crisis continues to affect us all, CHAT's foodbank is seeing more people each month who need urgent help for necessary items. Stocks are running low and your help is needed. Please consider whether you can help by donating.

• You can drop food at church, at the CHAT Office, or any of the supermarket drop off points.

• You can order a supermarket delivery directly to the CHAT Office or shop from the CHAT Amazon "wish list" if this is more convenient for you.

• You can send a financial donation and then CHAT can purchase the things they most need.

- You can download the Foodbank App which will alert you to the most needed items.
- You can follow the CHAT Facebook page (CHATMidDevon) and spread the news with others.

In April 2023 CHAT gave out nearly 300 crisis packs. Everyone who visits the foodbank receives a warm welcome and an offer of support and advice to help with any underlying issues that mean they are needing to visit the foodbank.
