International Day of Prayer for Eastern Christians



The International Day of Prayer for Eastern Christians is celebrated annually on the Sixth Sunday of Easter. Christians from all over Europe, the Middle East, the Horn of Africa and India will join together in solidarity on 14 May to pray that Eastern Christians may be strengthened in their faith so that they can continue to steadfastly give witness to Jesus Christ.

At Mass during Easter, Western and Eastern Christians hear the Acts of the Apostles which witness to the first preaching of the Gospel. These readings remind us of the origin of the Eastern Churches and the history of the first Eastern Christians, who brought the Gospel to us. Nowadays, many of these Eastern Christians are oppressed and persecuted, and struggle to survive and to pass on our faith to their children, in their own lands where Christianity was born and first spread.

Fellowship and Aid to the Christians of the East (FACE) is a Christian charity which draws on 170 years' experience of helping Eastern Christians to remain in their homelands – the biblical lands – where Christianity was born and first spread. Visit www.facecharity.org to find out more.
