## **Solemnity of St Peter and St Paul**



The Solemnity of St Peter and St Paul occurs this Thursday, 29 June. As this is a Holy Day of Obligation, when we are all called to come together to celebrate Mass, there will be a Vigil Mass for the Solemnity at 6.00pm in St Boniface on Wednesday 28 June and Masses on 29 June at 10.00am and 6.00pm in St James.

This Solemnity reminds us of the importance of our communion with the Successor of St Peter and Bishop of Rome, Pope Francis. The annual collection, traditionally called "Peter's Pence", will be taken at the Masses next weekend. This is our annual opportunity to contribute towards the charitable work of the Holy Father around the world. #### "Instrumentum Laboris" for the Synod in October 2023

The Instrumentum Laboris (or Working Document), a document of some 60 pages that incorporates the experiences of local Churches in every region of the world experiencina wars, climate change and economic systems that produce exploitation, inequality and waste, those whose faithful suffer martyrdom in countries where they are minorities or where they are coming to terms with an increasingly driven, and sometimes



aggressive, secularisation, those wounded by sexual abuse or abuses of power and conscience, those that are fearlessly confronting the challenges by engaging in the synodal discernment without trying to resolve them at all costs – was released on Tuesday morning. This document will be the basis for the work of the participants in the General Assembly of the Synod on Synodality, which begins in the Vatican in October 2023 and concludes with a second Assembly next year. This document is unique of its kind and is well worth reading and studying. A copy is attached to the Newsletter.
