Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation



This Sunday, the Solemnity of Chris the King, at the 10.00am Mass, 12 of our young people will be confirmed. This is a great blessing for our parish, so please do keep them in your prayers. Please note that the Mass in St Boniface will take start at 12noon as a result.

Youth Sunday

This Sunday is also Youth Sunday, the day on which we celebrate the role of young people and give thanks for their presence within our parish family; we remember that they are the future of the Church, and we pray that they will always know the presence and guidance of the Holy Spirit in their lives. It is a day to encourage young people to deepen their relationship with Jesus and explore various opportunities for them within the Church.

The theme for this year's Youth Sunday is "Come and See", a welcoming invitation from Jesus to young people, and indeed to the whole Church. It is inspired by words spoken by Pope Francis to young people gathered for the Welcome Ceremony in Lisbon for the International World Youth Day in August of this year: "You are not here by accident. The Lord has called you, not only in these days, but from the very beginning of your days. He called you by name. Let us listen to the word of God that called us by name. Try to imagine these three words written in large letters. Then consider that they were written within you, on your hearts, as if setting the direction of your lives, the meaning of who you are: you have been called by name. Each of us is called by name".
