World Communications Day

This Sunday is the 58th World Communications Day and the theme this year is "Artificial Intelligence and the Wisdom of the Heart: Towards a Fully Human Communication". Pope Francis' Message for this day can be read here. There will be a retiring collection to support the work of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales in their engagement with the various forms of national media to spread the message of our Faith.

New Lectionary and Sunday Missal

On the first Sunday of Advent this year, a new lectionary will be introduced at Mass which will use a different translation of the Scriptures – the English Standard Version Catholic Edition – and a revised translation of the Grail Psalms – the Abbey Psalms. As a result, all existing people's Missals will be out of date. A revised Sunday Missal from the Catholic Truth Society will be available for £19.95. However, if we order it via the Augustinian Recollects in Honiton, they will give a 10% discount. Thy Kingdom Come is an international and ecumenical movement between the Feasts of Ascension and Pentecost, started in 2016 by the Anglican Archbishops of Canterbury and York, that is a call to prayer to Christians around the world.
