

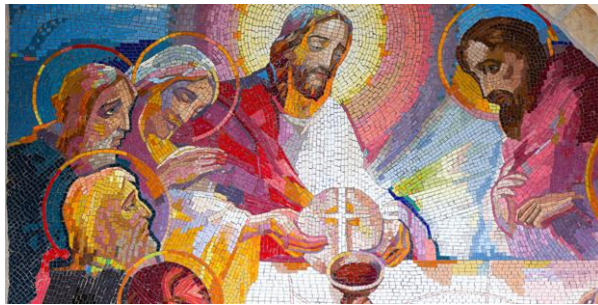

## Updating the Parish Database

## Parish Pilgrimage Walk to the Shrine of St Boniface, Crediton

This coming Tuesday, 24 June, we will be holding our parish pilgrimage walk from St Andrew's, Tiverton, to the National Shrine of St Boniface in Crediton. We hope many parishioners will join us for some parts of this special day of pilgrimage. We will be starting from St Andrew's Church at 7.00am and finishing with Mass celebrated by Canon Kristian at St Boniface Catholic Church in Crediton at 6.00pm.



The Parish Laudato Si' Group has prepared a leaflet which explains the 5 Stages of the walk and gives an indication of terrain and difficulty. People are welcome to join just for a stage or two, for the whole walk or just for the Mass at the Shrine. There will be someone leading each stage of the walk, who knows the route and each stage will begin with a prayer. We hope that the whole walk will be a prayerful experience, attentive to the beautiful mid-Devon countryside and the gifts of creation all around us. Well-behaved dogs are welcome to come along too! The leaflet is attached, together with a map of the whole Pilgrimage Walk.

It would really be helpful to know if you will be joining the walk at any stage and also if you will be taking part in the Mass. Members of the Laudato Si' Group will be around at Mass over this weekend to answer any questions you may have and to take down names.
