

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

In 2021, Pope Francis instituted a Church-wide celebration of a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly to be held on the fourth Sunday of July, close to the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. This day helps us to remember that the elderly are a gift, and we have a duty to ensure that they are looked after well in their final years. The Holy Father has chosen the theme of the Fifth World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly: "Blessed are those who have not lost hope" (Sir 14:2). In this Jubilee year, this Day is intended to be an opportunity to reflect on how the presence of grandparents and the elderly can become a sign of hope in every family and church community.
