Love in Action in the Holy Land – Catholic News Podcast

In a recent episode of the Catholic News <u>podcast</u>, with Anton Asfar, Secretary General of Caritas Jerusalem and Fr Elias Tabban, Parish Priest of Zababdeh Parish, near Jenin, we hear about the happy, hopeful but also cautious mood on the ground among the people following the Gaza ceasefire agreement which marks the end of the war and the beginning of the first phase of the peace process in the Holy Land. Fr Elias shares the experiences of local families and the ways the war has affected their lives, including how the local Christian and Muslims communities have been moved to build bridges and work together to overcome the challenges they are facing. We learn how the parish is the heart of the community, serving as a school, pastoral centre and place of entertainment, prayer and solace, not just for Christians, but also for the wider community.
