Solemnity of All Saints

St John Henry Newman, Doctor of the Church



During Mass this Saturday, 1 November, Pope Leo XIV will officially proclaim Saint John Henry Newman, the most recently canonised saint from England and Wales, the 38th Doctor of the Church.
